To begin creating a new report, you must first identify the type of experience (i.e., Employee vs. Volunteer/Self-Directed) before selecting a more specific category under Setting A or Setting O. We've also enhanced the "Add New Experience" process to guide you in creating accurate Setting A or Setting O reports with ease and have included steps in the report creation that help clarify the reporting requirements.

Due to NCARB's recent mobile-accessible updates to the Experience section of <u>my.ncarb.org</u>, we will be retiring the My AXP app on January 31, 2025.

With the improvements to My NCARB, you can now access My NCARB through your device's mobile browser for a seamless and improved user experience—providing all the features of the current My AXP app, as well as additional functionality!

Because the experience you report in the My AXP app is linked directly to your NCARB Record, **app users will not need to take any action**.
